Overview: *With the retirement of the Miscellaneous Laboratory Test, the Clinical Research Study teams involved with collecting specimens for research will utilize the Research Lab Study Lab in Cerner. This change will begin on 1/1/2020.*

Overview

As of January 1, 2020, the process for ordering a Miscellaneous Laboratory Test will change. In preparation for this change, a new **Research Study Lab** will be created in Cerner to fulfill clinical research testing purposes. The test will *mimic* the existing Miscellaneous Test functionality and allow for the following to be completed with the study orders:

1. Date/Time Label to be printed
2. Cross encounters and settings to accommodate all patient settings/locations
3. Special instructions for comments (i.e., specimen type, collection needed, etc.)

On 1/1/2020, please begin using the new Research Study Lab for all clinical research lab specimen collection.
